Scope of Work

- Evaluate achievements against objectives and results frameworks
- Assess project design, partnerships, and expert deployments
- Analyse sustainability and cross-cutting themes (e.g. gender, environment)
- Provide actionable, forward-looking recommendations

The review will include document analysis, stakeholder interviews, and potentially field visits.

- At least 7 years' experience in evaluation of development/humanitarian projects
- Demonstrated ability to assess Norad-funded or similar programmes
- Strong report-writing and analytical skills
- Expertise in at least two of the following:
 - o Climate information services and adaptation programming
 - o National/regional climate institutions and governance
 - o Community resilience and climate adaptation

Field travel may be required.
